Jack Varaly

Jack Varaly was available to answer questions regarding the Halbing garage permit that was believed to be issued in error. Council discussed what the options were now that construction has already been started. Council believes that due to an incomplete application, and no Penn Dot Highway Occupancy Permit being issued, they are issuing a Cease and Desist order. Jack Varaly will write a letter to have Attorney McCormick approve, to be sent out immediately.

Jack Varaly also stated the need to update the form the Borough is using for a Zoning Permit. He will send the borough an updated form to use.

Jack Varaly also went over the Harveys Lake Borough Zoning Update that was terms currently defined in Article 2 that must be either assigned to a specific zoning district or be eliminated if council believes they are unlikely uses that will occur in the Borough.

2009 Preliminary Budget

John B. Brokenshire presented the 2009 Preliminary Budget for approval. He answered questions.

Garbage fee request

There was request from Sam Shurinkos of Peach St. requesting a reduction in his garbage fee. Council pointed out that according to Borough Ordinance; all homeowners are required to pay the full fee regardless of amount of garbage they discard.

Police Septic System

Council requested a contract be drawn up to be signed by the contractors being hired to install the police septic system upgrade, and the police carpet installation.

Borton Lawson

Borton Lawson submitted the bill for the work they did for the Liquid Fuels project on Trolley hill. It is in the amount of \$10,830.00. It needs to be brought to the floor to authorize payment from the Liquid Fuels account.
